Counselor-in-Training Expectations

JFD Counselor-in-Training position is designed to offer young people an opportunity to prepare for positions as educators. Emphasis is placed upon developing leadership skills, sensitivity to children, and program skills in movement and dance.

Guided by JFD professional educators, CITs will develop their decision-making and problem-solving skills by assisting with daily activities and camper care.



CIT Requirements

CITs must be at least 12 years old.

CITs must possess a genuine interest in movement and dance, classroom management, youth development and in working with campers ages 5-11.

CITs must be willing to commit the required energy, enthusiasm, and **positive attitude** to all aspects of camp. This includes actively supporting the instructors' lesson plan by fully participating in the activities, by encouraging and guiding campers to follow behavior guidelines and classroom etiquette, by setting an excellent example for embracing correction, responding positively to feedback, and by supporting the educational objectives of the camp program.

CITs must assist campers and follow building regulations for social distance requirements, restroom and water breaks directives, and hallway, snack and lunch etiquette.

Completing the camp week as a CIT is a positive addition to any resume, giving teens the confidence they need to become successful leaders at camp or in their communities.
